Prabh Aasra is providing shelter, care and treatment to those who are deprived of the rehabilitation opportunities by helping the helpless/unclaimed mentally/physically challenged, neglected, orphaned, underprivileged, old aged, ailing, needy persons, widows and missing destitute stranded on the roadside without care brought for admission to our organization since 2003. We want to achieve a friendly society to help our fellow beings where each and every opportunity and support will be provided to needy citizens for their development.

## COVID-19 EMERGENCY RESPONSE: SITUATION ON GROUND

The pandemic stimulation during Covid-19 first wave breakout was reason for the sharp rises in unemployment and underemployment, leaving families with fewer resources to address their most basic needs—food, heat, and shelter. Prabh Aasra worked to help the needy citizens as well as assisted and supported local administrations in facilitating the **ambulance and medicinal services** and also provided relief, masks, sanitizers and ration to the poor, down-trodden, and homeless. More than **7000** Ration kits (Cereals ,oil, pulses, Fruits, flour, Rice, Soaps and Spices) were dispersed to the needy with the support of Volunteers and donors.



Prabh Aasra® is a non-profit NGO registered as Universal Disabled Caretaker Social Welfare Society under Society Registration Act, 12 AA, Juvenile Justice Act, PWD Act, National Trust, NITI AYO, 80G and FCRA. The increasing inflow of residents is creating an urgency to expand our infrastructure to provide them the necessary services. Recent Works are :

- **Shelter Homes:** Prabh Aasra is working to provide shelter, care and treatment to the helpless people as well as the children who lost either one or both parental support due to Covid-19 or any other reason where they can live with dignity. Currently running 3 shelter homes (24 X 7) have inhabitants for more than 393 helpless people staying.
- **Supplying Oxygen Concentrates:** Coronavirus second wave has pushed many people in facing life threatening situations due to COVID-19 symptoms along with lacking of oxygen Concentrators and cylinders supplies. During this hard time, Prabh Aasra is providing Oxygen Concentrators from time to time to the needy citizens of different areas free of cost.
- **Mobile Toilet vans:** To provide the access to clean toilets, Prabh Aasra took the initiative and supported 6 toilet vans facility as help under the name of project 'Washroom on Wheels'.
- **Vaccination Camps:** Prabh Aasra has been working in collaboration with the local



## DURING COVID-19: MEDICAL FACILITY

As with single-day spikes in Covid-19 cases during second wave deteriorating situations in hospitals which are full with Covid positive cases or post Covid symptoms, even refusing treatment of patients suffering from general acute diseases other than Covid which lot of times leads to painful life and death. So, in this painful situation Prabh Aasra had been forced by these unavoidable circumstances to start the hospital to save the valuable life of citizens. The main motive to start this project is to provide unconditional medical support especially during emergency times and to provide the medical facility at charitable rates to those who can't afford it.



Government to organize vaccination Camps of Covid-19 for the Inhabitants of Prabh Aasra as well as general public.

- **Public Toilets:** The public toilets for the general as well as handicapped citizens has been constructed over the National Highway of Grant Trunk Road, outside Prabh Aasra Hospital, Chanalon, Kurali, SAS Nagar (Mohali).
- **Langar Hall Project:** As for the most important need is food for such a large number of people residing in Prabh Aasra and due to lack of capacity of our existing system, our residents are facing lots of different problems which is forcing us to switch over to new kitchen appliances. The Langar Hall project with hot steam boilers for cooking will increase the capacity and variety of cooking by supporting us to cater food for more than **1000 people** within 3-4 hours. In case of emergency, the new Boiler can help and support to provide cooked food to the affected individuals/ families, front line workers, needy citizens and various others.
- **IPD Services:** To provide medical emergency service in night hours, Prabh Aasra has started the emergency services to treat the helpless and premises needy citizens.
- **Pharmaceutical Shop:** The pharmaceutical chemist shop is also started within hospital to serve unconditionally to destitute and accidental victims in case of emergency services. The medicines are being served at charitable rates to the needy citizens.
- **Mission Millap:** With due care and treatment which leads to improvement in the health of inhabitants, they reveal their whereabouts. Prabh Aasra contacts the concerned Police Authorities to trace and reunite with their respective families to hand over to them. By the end of June 2021, **1921** has been admitted to society and out of that **1275** has been handed over to their whereabouts.
